Concept

The COVID-19 pandemic has had a big impact on the implementation of mobility programmes throughout Europe. The consequences are still to be fully explored, but it is certain that physical mobility will especially be affected by current and future circumstances. How are current programmes being affected? What will count as a mobility period? What about students staying in their home country and enrolling in online courses at their host universities?
